a) Whether there is any conflict with the partner or not?b) Whether the partner is capable or not?c) Whether the partner is willing for the partnership or not?


- India and Japan have non-conflicting relations based on a common culture

The 5% vs. 95% Model



- The 5% followed an resource and energy intense model during their development
- The danger lies in the 95% following the same unsustainable model of development
- The 95% should therefore follow a new socio-economic framework based on energy efficiency, environment responsibility and the sustainability



# DELHI – MUMBAI INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR (DMIC):

THE LARGEST SYMBOL OF CO-OPERATION BETWEEN INDIA AND JAPAN

**DMIC**, was based on the Vision – Ideation – Evangelize – Incubate – Incorporate model and executed as a PPP with the untiring efforts of India Center.

An MoU relating to DMIC was signed between the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) of Japan and Ministry of Commerce and Industry (MoCI) of India.

## Vision:


- (1) To re-establish India's industrial culture that was lost during by British colonization
- (2) To create a globally competitive, strong economic base with state-of-the-art infrastructure to activate local commerce, enhance foreign investments and attain sustainable development
- (3) To be developed as a Model Industrial Corridor of international standard
- (4) To transform the DMIC region into a 'Global Manufacturing and Trading Hub'

## WHAT IS THE DELHI – MUMBAI INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR (DMIC)?



## **DELHI- MUMBAI INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR (DMIC)**

- A large-scale project that aims to establish a 1483 km Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) between Delhi and Mumbai
- 150 km on both sides of this Freight Corridor to be developed as the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor
- Will pass through 6 states: U.P., Delhi (NCR), Haryana, Rajasthan, Gujarat and Maharashtra
- Is being equipped with an array of infrastructure facilities such as power facilities, rail connectivity and ports

#### **DELHI MUMBAI INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR: FROM VISION TO REALITY**

RELATIONSHIP (INDIA-JAPAN)

India faces various challenges in the fields of health, education, infrastructure, urban, rural development, agriculture or logistics in order to sustain its 1.2 billion population.

Japan's economy is hard in nature and it has surplus know how, resources and besides expertise in various technologies, in which it can contribute significantly in making India stronger! Indian economy being soft in nature is based on several sectors like agriculture, IT, Biotechnology, Research and Development

When PM Koizumi visited India officially in year 2005, India Center proposed along with political scions like Shinzo Abe (who was Koizumi's Deputy Cabinet Secretary) to establish solutions and answers to questions like why India and why Japan, by including in the Joint statement a new Mantra "Stronger India-Stronger Japan and Stronger Japan-Stronger India".

Besides differences in social and economic nature, the complementarities can create a platform for India and Japan to work as global partners and also give similar solutions to rest of Asia and the world! Broadening the vision, theory and providing visual content to symbol of this new framework was required.

#### MECHANISM (DELHI-MUMBAI INDUSTRIAL CORRIDOR)

#### INCUBATION

Based on age old Indo-Gangetic corridor (where along the banks of Ganga: a whole civilization developed thousands of years ago due to ease of water and transportation) and also taking a hint from Japan's successful pacific-corridor, which runs from Tokyo to Hiroshima; where an environment friendly, energy efficient transport system developed along with a new industrial culture, an industrial corridor was proposed between Delhi and Mumbai in 2002 by India Center, which has today become the largest symbol of co-operation between India and Japan.

India Center played a constructive contributor as a catalyst taking these forward looking positive wishes (DMIC and DFC) of both the countries to a logical end, which was also included in the joint statement of both the nations !


- Industrial Culture of India
